CAMP OVERVIEW

- Our Day Camp is planned for teen's 6th-10th grade. This six (6) week program will be held at the **Tenafly Teen Center and Municipal Field**, Monday through Friday, starting Monday, June 27th through Friday, August 5th from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. Camp is held **RAIN** or **SHINE**. This camp will comply with the youth summer camp requirements of the NJ Department of Health.



CAMP CHECKLIST (Mandatory)

- ✓ **SUNSCREEN, TOWEL, METAL COOLING WATER BOTTLE** (*Please label all items with your campers names*)
- ✓ **SNEAKERS ONLY** (*no flip flops, crocs, open toed shoes*) this is important to avoid injury while participating in any activities.
- ✓ **PACKED LUNCH** (*Please label with your campers name*)

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

DROP-OFF INSTRUCTIONS:



- Upon arrival, all campers should be dropped off at the Teen Center. The Camp Director will take attendance every day at 9:00am.
- If your camper arrives late, please bring them or direct them to the front desk of the Teen Center for further assistance.

- Non-essential staff, parents or visitors will not be allowed on premise during camp hours of operation

DISMISSAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Camp dismissal is at 3:00pm. PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD PROMPTLY AT 3:00pm.**
- Non-essential staff, parents or visitors will not be allowed on premise during camp hours of operation



LATE PICK-UP

- The Teen Center will be open at 3:00pm if your camper would like to stay with the day staff in the center before you arrive for pick-up.

DAY CAMP SCHEDULE / ACTIVITIES

- You will be emailed the 2022 Teen Camp Calendar through email. The calendar will indicate each day's special event and any trips that are scheduled.

LUNCH

- All lunches will be kept indoors to keep them as cool as possible or refrigerated if needed. Please encourage your child to clean up after themselves. Please notify your director if your camper requires any allergy requests.



TRIPS

- **No registration will be accepted the day of a trip.** Each camper is responsible for any money they bring on a trip. Staff **will not** be responsible for holding money and/or valuables. If you registered for trips, please make sure all your waivers are signed. **There will be NO refunds issued for trips.**

TRIP SUPERVISION, PARTICIPATION AND GUIDELINES

- Supervision/chaperone will be available on all trips. Departure for all trips will be organized in front of the Teen Center. **Campers must first report to their group for attendance. Please be on time on trip days, we will not wait for campers if they are late to camp that day, the time listed is the time the bus will leave.**
- The return time for all trips will be approximate. Please be at the Teen Center for pickup at the estimated arrival time.

SWIM DAYS

- Campers will be eligible to go to the local swim club **provided they have returned their swim time permission slip to their director.** Campers will go to the swim club on a rotating basis.

WE WILL DO OUR PART TO ENFORCE HEALTH AND SAFETY AT OUR CAMP!



- Intense cleaning, sanitation, disinfection, and ventilation before, during, and after all activities
- Frequently clean, sanitize and disinfect sporting equipment, restrooms, tables, frequently used touch point and sensor areas, faucets, sinks, floors, etc.
- Encourage frequent hand washing

INCLEMENT WEATHER & HEAT WAVE



- Camp will be held RAIN or SHINE.
- In case of a heat wave the campers will utilize indoors in the air conditioning or in shaded areas on the field.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS/ILLNESS



- Keep your camper home if they are sick or show any signs of illness.
- Anyone showing signs of illness of any kind or who may have been exposed to COVID-19 will not be permitted to enter the camp facility. Please contact your physician for follow up questions or information regarding your camper's health.
- There will be a specified isolation area for all staff and campers that are ill or showing any signs of illness.

IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION



- Any special needs and/or restrictions of a camper must be put into writing by the parent or guardian and given to the Recreation Director 1 week prior to the start date of camp.
- Signage will be posted as well as social distancing markings throughout camp grounds. Health & Safety Plan posted at campsite.
