ORDINANCE NO. 06-34

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY
COMMITTEE ON THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES
ACT ("ADA") FOR THE BOROUGH OF TENAFLY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Tenafly deem it to be in the best interests of the Borough to form an advisory committee to deal with the concerns of disabled citizens, barrier-free facilities, employment practices and general and specific compliance with the federal legislation known as the Americans with Disabilities Act; and

WHEREAS, the composition of such committee is both crucial to and required by the terms of appropriate legislation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Tenafly, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby formed an 'Advisory Committee for the Disabled' to consider, deal with and provide advice and counsel to the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Tenafly as to the concerns of the disabled persons, barrier-free facilities, employment practices and the like and general and specific compliance with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act and any appropriate legislation dealing with the subject matter hereof; and

Section 2. The said 'Advisory Committee for the Disabled' will be composed of the following classes of persons:

- A. The Committee shall be comprised of at least 7 and no more than 9 voting members, who shall be persons with disabilities, or parents of a child with a disability, or a resident family member who is the caregiver of a person with a disability. The balance of the Committee shall be non-voting members composed of the following Borough Departments or representatives: Liaison to the Mayor and Council; Construction Official, Recreation, DPW, School District, and a member of the Business Community.

- A. The specific appointments to the aforesaid Committee shall be made by the Mayor and Council for three-year terms, such appointments to be made by the Mayor and Council within one month after the adoption of this Ordinance.
- B. The Committee as constituted shall meet at least quarterly, shall by a majority vote select a chairman to serve for a one-year period, such selection to be made each year and shall act pursuant to by-laws to be created by the Committee and adopted by a majority vote thereof within 90 days from the formation of the Committee.
- C. The record of proceedings of committee meetings shall be kept, and such record as well as any recommendations or advice of the committee to the Mayor and Council, shall be provided no later than 60 days after each meeting.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.


