NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE is hereby given that Sealed Bids will be received by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Tenafly in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, for the project known as **FURNISHING AND INSTALLATION OF MUNICIPAL CENTER EMERGENCY GENERATOR**. There will be a **mandatory pre-bid meeting on November 4, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. at Tenafly Borough Hall**.

Copies of specifications and other bid documents are on file and open to public inspection during regular business hours (M-F from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) in the office of the Borough Administrator located in Borough Hall in the Municipal Center, 100 Riveredge Road, Tenafly, New Jersey. Sets of these documents may be obtained at the office of the Borough Engineer, Schwanewede/Hals Engineering, 9 Post Road, Suite M-11, Oakland, New Jersey, phone 201-337-0053, for a non-returnable fee of \$125 payable to Schwanewede/Hals Engineering. Bid documents may be picked up between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., except weekends and holidays, until 4:00 P.M. on Monday, November 16, 2009.

Bids must be submitted on the Bid Proposal Forms provided and the entire bid booklet must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder on the outside of the envelope and marked "**BID FOR FURNISHING AND INSTALLATION OF MUNICIPAL CENTER EMERGENCY GENERATOR**" and addressed to Nancy Hatten, Borough Clerk, Borough of Tenafly, 100 Riveredge Road, Tenafly, NJ 07670. To be considered, the Bid must be accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or bona fide Bid Bond made payable to the Borough of Tenafly, NJ in the minimum amount of Ten Percent (10%) of the Amount Bid.

BIDS ARE TO BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 11:00 A.M. PREVAILING TIME ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2009, AT WHICH TIME THEY WILL BE OPENED AND READ ALOUD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS LOCATED IN BOROUGH HALL IN THE MUNICIPAL CENTER AT 100 RIVEREDGE ROAD, TENAFLY, NEW JERSEY.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A.10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C.17:27. In addition, bidders are notified that they must pay the prevailing wage rate as determined by the "New Jersey Wage Act, Chapter 150 of the Laws of 1963", extension effective July 1974. Also required, in compliance with P.L. 2004, c.57, is proof of business registration as evidenced by a copy of a Business Registration Certificate issued by the N.J. Department of the Treasury, Division of Revenue. In compliance with N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48, the "Public Works Contractor Registration Act", all contractors bidding on this project must be registered with the NJ Department of Labor and proof of registration is required at the time of bid submission.

The character and amount of bid security to be furnished by the bidder is stated in the "Instruction to Bidders" contained in the bid specifications. No bid may be withdrawn within sixty days after the scheduled time for receipt of the bids.

The Mayor and Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids for any cause whatsoever. The award or rejection of bids will occur within sixty (60) days of receipt of bids, at which time all bid guarantees will be returned in compliance with Local Public Contracts Law.
