#### **Halloween Day- Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>:**

##### **Trick-or-Treating Recommendations:**

- Porch light on = trick or treat here
- Porch light off = no trick or treating
- Yes / No signs on front door
- Stay in individual family group
- Stay in your immediate neighborhood
- Wear face mask (costume mask does not count)
- Social distancing
- Only give or take candy that is factory sealed
- Consider leaving candy on a table near your sidewalk / driveway

##### **Cotswold Area – trick-or-treating will be limited to Cotswold residents only:**

Cotswold area includes: Serpentine, Elm Street, Inness, Sherwood, Oak Street, and The Glen. The Tenafly Police will be present in the Cotswold area to ensure the prevention of crowds.
